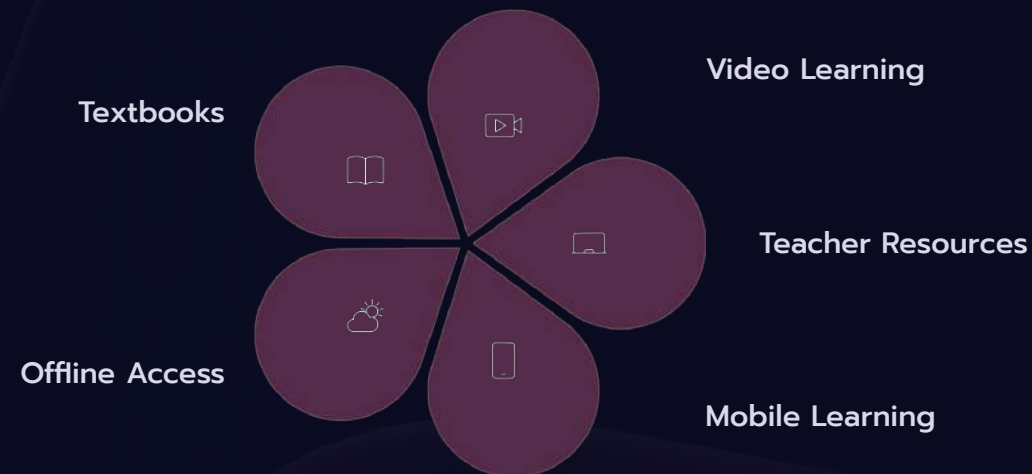


What is ePathshala?



ePathshala is a digital learning platform jointly developed by NCERT and the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Launched in November 2015 under the Digital India Initiative, it provides free, easy access to educational resources for students, teachers, parents, and researchers.

Core Purpose: Make quality educational content digitally available and support technology-based teaching and learning.



Objectives of ePathshala

Universal Access

Provide free digital educational resources to every learner across India.

Digital Culture

Reduce dependency on physical textbooks; promote paperless learning.



Promote Digital Learning

Encourage ICT integration in the teaching-learning process.

Support Teachers

Provide teaching materials, manuals, and lesson-planning support.

Inclusive Education

Reach learners in remote and disadvantaged areas.

NCERT textbooks for Classes 1–12 available digitally.



Mobile Accessibility

Accessible via mobile app, tablet, and laptop.



Offline Learning

Download resources for offline study.



Multimedia Resources

Educational videos, audio lessons, and animations.



Multi-language Support

Content in English, Hindi, Urdu, and regional languages.



Teacher Support

Manuals, lesson plans, and academic support materials.

Parents

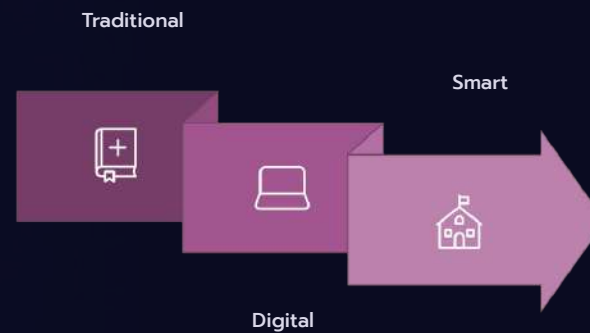
Support children's learning at home with curated content.

Improves access for all learners across India.



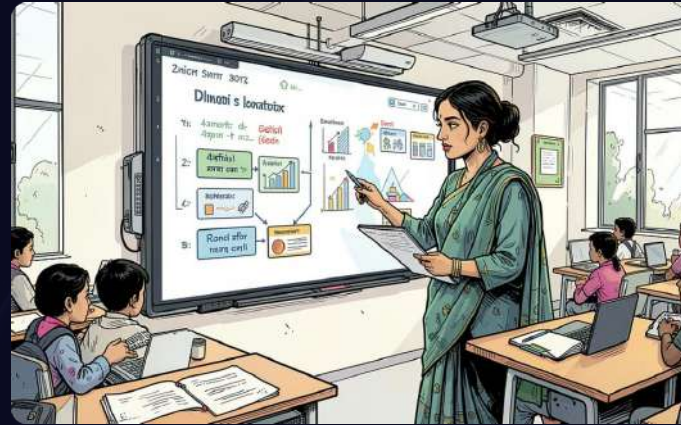
This flow illustrates how ePathshala bridges traditional education with a modern, inclusive, and technology-enabled learning environment.

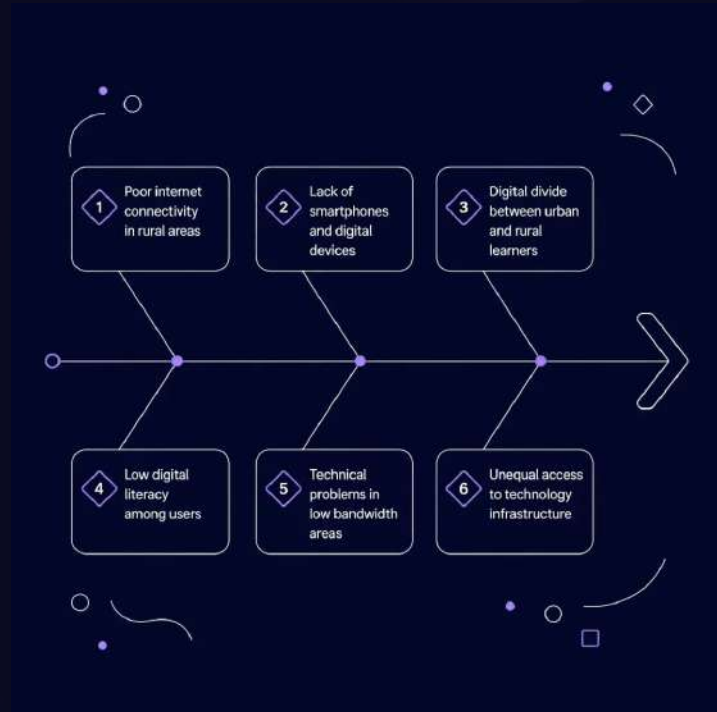

Challenges in Implementation



While ePathshala is a transformative initiative, its full potential is constrained by structural and infrastructural challenges, particularly in rural and semi-urban India.

⚠️ Connectivity Gap

Poor internet in rural areas limits access.

⚠️ Device Shortage

Lack of smartphones and digital devices among learners.

⚠️ Digital Literacy

Low digital literacy among teachers and students.

⚠️ Infrastructure Inequality

Unequal access to technology across regions.
