Research Papers

Full Papers: 5,000 – 8,000 words, excluding references

Abstracts

- Length: 300 500 words
- · Should summarize background, objectives, methods, and key insights
- Should have 3-5 keywords.

Formatting Requirements

- · File Format: MS Word (.doc, .docx) or PDF
- · Font: Times New Roman, 12-point
- · Line Spacing: 1.5
- Margins: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides
- · Referencing Style: APA (latest edition) preferred
