#### Research Papers

- Full Papers: 5,000 – 8,000 words, excluding references

#### Abstracts

- Length: 300 – 500 words
- Should summarize background, objectives, methods, and key insights
- Should have 3-5 keywords.

#### Formatting Requirements

- File Format: MS Word (.doc, .docx) or PDF
- Font: Times New Roman, 12-point
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- Margins: 1 inch (2.54 cm) on all sides
- Referencing Style: APA (latest edition) preferred

### STRUCTURE

1. Title Page: Title, author(s), affiliation(s), and contact info for corresponding author
2. Abstract & Keywords: Brief summary and 3–5 keywords
3. Introduction: Context, rationale, and objectives
4. Literature Review/Background
5. Methodology/Approach
6. Results & Discussion
7. Conclusions & Recommendations
8. References

### SUBMISSION PROCESS

- Submit manuscripts through the email address [researchcellofnamce@gmail.com](mailto:researchcellofnamce@gmail.com).
- All papers must be original, unpublished, and not under review elsewhere.
- The language of submission and presentation: English.

### REVIEW PROCESS


- All submissions undergo double-blind peer review.
- Evaluation criteria include originality, relevance, rigor, and clarity.
- Notification of acceptance or suggestions for revision will be sent to authors.

### PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Oral Presentations: 15–20 minutes per speaker, followed by Q&A
- Virtual (online) presentations are welcome for international delegates and remote participants.
